2017-2018 ANNUAL REPORT



Since 1990, our mission has been a simple one of dedication to relieving hunger in metro Detroit and preventing nutritious food waste. We achieved this by rescuing and distributing, free of charge, as much food as possible for the community we serve. After 25 years of making an impact in the lives of metro Detroiters, we took an opportunity, made possible by a Kresge Foundation grant, to look at how we are serving the community and if there were improvements to be made.

We found that our yearly nutritional mix was close to the USDA proper mix. In addition, we recognized that on a day-to-day basis there was room for improvement in our distribution model. Based on these findings, we have decided to make a pivot, changing our food sourcing and distribution model to create a more nutritionally balanced mix on a daily basis. We are also using data collected through the Link2Feed system to understand more about the people we are helping. This information will help us learn more about the individual needs of each family or person in our lines and to determine if there are areas that we are under serving. From this information Forgiven Harvest will be able to create a system of fresh nutritious food delivery that will ensure the **Right Food, Right Place, Right Quantity and Right Time.**

During our 2017-18 fiscal year, we finalized a 3-year Strategic Plan that will set us on the road for change. During this plan, we will pursue greater community impact by creating an enhanced, effective, and more sustainable food security network with nutritious food equity.

WHAT'S NEW AT FORGOTTEN HARVEST?

Kids Room

We believe that it is important for children to learn about food insecurity and food waste, so they can be part of addressing these problems in metro Detroit. That's why we, with the help of the Community Foundation for Southeast Michigan, created the Food Rescuers Youth Engagement Initiative. This program includes both service and education opportunities for kindergarten through eighth graders. School groups, faith-based summer programs, YMCA camps and more have already participated in our food repacks at our warehouse and at their own locations. Since May 2018, over 60,000 pounds of nutritious food that would have otherwise gone to waste have been repacked through this program. The kids also made over 3,700 sandwiches for our Summer Lunch Program. In addition to the volunteer repack experience, students have learned about the nutritional benefits of the food they repacked, the scope of hunger and food insecurity in our community, various ways we can prevent food waste, and how they can spread the word about Forgotten Harvest's mission.



Link2Feed

During FY 2017-2018 we initiated a new program called Link2Feed. This networked client intake program was set up so that we can learn more about the needs, stories, and demographics of people receiving food from Forgotten Harvest's network of over 260 agency partners. We are gathering information to bring a better understanding of the "why?" behind food insecurity. This new Link2Feed data will inform our operations and help us improve food variety for nutritional value, better calculate the amount of food needed in the community and measure impact on the community. From this information, we are already starting to gather important insights and are able to create a heat map of need. This new Link2Feed data will help us expand the use of data analysis to support our service. So far we have just over 15% of our agencies fully integrated. As we continue to on board more agencies, the network will continue to grow and our data collection will become more comprehensive. Not only will Link2Feed help us in our mission, it will also affect our vision: communities that work together to end hunger and increase individual, neighborhood, economic, and environmental health through bettering resource sharing, referrals and data-informed service creation. With continued training and support of this network, Forgotten Harvest will be one of the leaders in data related to food insecurity, poverty, economic stability and economic mobility.
